



Tour de TART (Aug 7, 2009) Your gift to TART Trails

Your registration fees to participate in Tour de TART have a direct and meaningful impact on TART Trails. At year end, when you are preparing your taxes, you may be able to deduct a portion of your registration as a gift to TART Trails, Inc. However, as Tour de TART is an event and not a simple contribution to TART Trails, you'll need to calculate the amount you may deduct.

First, you'll need the total amount paid to TART to participate in Tour de TART. If you paid for others to participate, that amount can go into this total as well. This number is the total amount you paid to TART Trails to participate in the event.

Second, you will need to multiply the number of participants in the event that you've paid for by \$10. If it's just yourself, that's \$10, For you and your spouse, it would be \$20. This number represents the "fair market value" of the goods and services you received during Tour de TART. This total needs to be subtracted from the registration fees paid to TART Trails.

That calculation (total registration fees minus \$10 per participant) represents the gift amount that you've given to TART Trails with your participation in Tour de TART. This form, when complete, will serve as your Tour de TART receipt for tax purposes.
